

Malnutrition


Every 3 seconds a child dies from hunger, malnutrition or related disease.

5 million people were displaced in 2006, and none of them had help from their own governments





Trusted partners in lasting change




- We walk alongside communities as they unlock their potential and unleash the gifts of their people.

- In the light of this new spirit, solutions beyond our dreams bring security and choices to the world's most vulnerable people.






Powerful motivators of caring

- As we join together in this wonderful endeavour, we find our own lives enriched in ways we could never imagine.






Child - Focused Development Model



Where they flourish in a world where the treasure of our hearts and the measure of our wealth is the happiness and well-being of all children.



Ausper




- Ausper lives with her sister, 2 brothers, and 1 sister. Her sister is a subsistence farmer and struggles to provide for the family. Despite his efforts, it is difficult to meet the family's needs.
- Ausper and her family live in a community severely affected by the HIV/AIDS crisis. In some communities, AIDS affects the entire social structure as a generation of hardworking adults is being wiped out. Frightened children and exhausted grandparents rarely have money for food, school, or medical care. Through sponsorship, you can help with these and other basic needs for Ausper and her family.
- Ausper is not in school at this time. She likes to play ball games. She helps at home by learning to do small tasks. She is in satisfactory health.
- Your sponsorship commitment will help provide Ausper and her community with the assistance they need to save a generation from the HIV/AIDS crisis. World Vision will faithfully use your sponsorship support of Ausper to meet her needs and minimize the impact of AIDS in her community through tangible prevention and care programs. Jorge


- Jorge Eduardo lives with his relatives and has no brothers or sisters. His relatives struggle to provide for the family.
- Jorge Eduardo lives in a rural community 391 miles south of Mexico City. A typical home is built with adobe and usually has one single room. Corn, tortillas, beans and chili are staples of the diet. Meat, chicken and fish are eaten once in a while. The climate is hot and humid with temperatures reaching 107 degrees and falling to only 73 degrees. The local terrain is plain and eroded.
- Jorge Eduardo is not in school at this time because the child is still too young. He likes to play ball games. He helps at home by learning to do small tasks. He is in good health.
- Your sponsorship commitment will help provide Jorge Eduardo and his community with improved health care and hygiene and better housing as well as support for children with learning disabilities. Access to education will be made available to both children and adults, which will open up the doors for a brighter future. Through Christian witness, these precious families will have the opportunity to learn more about the grace and love of God.



My Sponsored Children

Santiago

- Santiago Andres lives with his parents and 1 brother. His parents struggle to provide for the family. His father is a construction worker and his mother takes care of the household. Despite their efforts it is difficult to meet the family's needs.
- Santiago Andres is growing up in an urban community that is 186 miles from our World Vision office. Due to the last earthquake, the homes are constructed of wood with cement flooring. Some are in unstable areas. Families eat rice, eggs, beans and plantains. The climate is mild, and the community is located in a mountainous area where the soil is volcanic and good for agriculture.
- Santiago Andres is not in school at this time because the child is still too young. He likes to play with a musical rattle. He helps at home by learning to do small tasks. He is in good health.
- Your sponsorship commitment will help provide Santiago Andres and his community with special health care, inoculations against major disease and special feeding programs for undernourished children. In this area, devastated by earthquake and war, your support will help reconstruct the community. We are thankful for your commitment and your prayers so these precious children and their families are able to experience the love of God and life in all its fullness.



My Sponsored Children

Aldair

- Aldair lives with his mother and 1 sister. His mother takes care of the household and struggles to provide for the family. Despite her efforts, it is difficult to meet the family's needs.
- Aldair is growing up in an urban community within Lima, the capital city of Peru. The typical family home is constructed of cement bricks and wood matting. The local diet consists mostly of potatoes, noodles, bread and rice. The climate is arid and humid with high temperatures to 86 degrees and lows to 53 degrees. The land is very dry.
- Aldair is not in school at this time because the child is still too young. He likes to play with toy cars. He helps at home by doing the family chores. He is in good health.
- Your sponsorship commitment will help provide Aldair and his community with improved health care, nutritional workshops, occupational training, and an environmental campaign. It will also provide an opportunity for both children and parents to receive schooling and participate in holiday celebrations for the community. In addition, with Christian witness, they will have a chance to know God's grace and love.
